Annual Meeting  
August 26, 2018

Following the worship service the meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Connie Funkhouser with the Pledge of Allegiance and an Opening Prayer.

**Minutes:** Nancy moved and Joan seconded that the minutes be approved as printed. Motion carried.

**Old Business:** No response has been received from the owner of a small parcel of land between the LCP and the campground. Larry Johnson contacted him a few months ago about a possible purchase of this parcel.

**New Business:** Kari moved and Joan seconded a motion to accept a gift of 300 coffee cups from Lem Miller and have the LCP information printed on them at \$1.00 per cup.

**Annual Reports:**

Pastor Tom: The membership is growing and we are getting positive feedback and very little negative feedback. Bible study is ongoing and we are waiting for winter to begin the Community Bible Study Program. Tom said he likes being in Island Park and enjoys the members and believes we work well as a group. Financially we are doing okay. He is looking to buy a house in Idaho Falls to use when he retires from the Little Church in the Pines. He noted that people are not signing up to clean the building.

Under comments Joan Moore suggested that everyone might be able to sign up for two weeks a year.

Under comments to Connie's report several guests mentioned that Pastor Tom being here has had many good effects on the community.

Under comments Larry said he was having difficulty getting bids for the roof and Connie offered to have Doug Jorgensen help with the bid. Greg and Tom worked with RCCM (Jo Daniels) to improve the reporting/auditing process for accuracy. LCP's payment to RCCM for bookkeeping and insurance remains at \$180.00 per month. Gordon Hanson discussed if there might be an amount reserved for emergency or unpredicted needs.
